



# Coastal Bend COLLEGE

The Coastal Bend College Board (CBC) of Trustees is inviting qualified applicants who would like to serve as a CBC trustee to submit application packets by 12 p.m. (noon) on Thursday, July 8, 2021.

CBC Trustee Taylor Tomlin submitted his resignation on June 15, 2021. Mr. Tomlin holds CBC Trustee Place 7. In accordance with Texas Education Code Section 130.082(d), the individual appointed to fill Mr. Tomlin's position shall serve until May 2022, when elections will be held. If the appointed individual chooses to run for election, he/she may do so and if he/she wins, he/she would serve for the remainder until the May 2022 Trustee election is canvassed.

Qualified individuals who are interested in being appointed to the vacant position on the CBC Board of Trustees shall apply by submitting the following items:

- (1) a brief letter of interest, containing the individual's name, address of residence within Bee County, contact information (including an e-mail address and telephone number), statement regarding reasons for interest in the vacant position, and qualifications; and
- (2) a current resume.

Application packets may be submitted by mail, hand delivery, or by e-mail. Application packets submitted by mail or hand delivery must be addressed to the Board Chair, Victor Gomez, at the CBC Administration Building, 3800 Charco Road, Beeville, Texas 78102, and marked "Trustee Vacancy." Application packets must be received no later than 12 p.m. noon on Thursday, July 8, 2021. Application packets that are submitted by e-mail should be sent to Anna Garcia, Executive Assistant to the Board, at [agarcia@coastalbend.edu](mailto:agarcia@coastalbend.edu). Applicants who submit application packets via e-mail should receive confirmation of receipt within two business days after submittal, but in the event an applicant does not receive a confirmation e-mail by then, the applicant should contact Ms. Garcia at (361) 354-2207.

The Board of Trustees may deliberate the appointment of a board member in closed session in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act and may also seek the advice of legal counsel. The meeting will be posted and conducted in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Any action taken by the CBC Board of Trustees to fill the vacant position will occur at a properly noticed meeting of the Board.

To be eligible to be appointed to the CBC Board of Trustees Place 7 seat, a person must possess the following qualifications:

- (1) Be a United States citizen.
- (2) Be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the date of appointment.
- (3) Have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be:
  - a. Totally mentally incapacitated; or
  - b. Partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote.
- (4) Have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.
- (5) Have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and in Bee County for six months immediately preceding the date the appointment is made.
- (6) On the date described by item 5, be registered to vote in Bee County.
